CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

LENGTHY

Half have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE

30% have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

58% are women

20% are 65 years old or older

37% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

Nearly 10%

are providing care to someone with dementia
