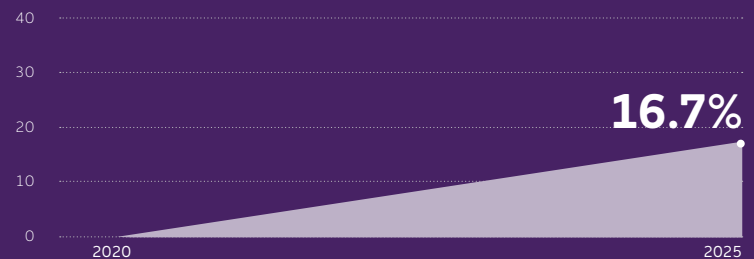

More than **5 million Americans** are living with Alzheimer's.
