

Over 5 million

Americans are living with Alzheimer's, and nearly **14 million** will have the disease in 2050. The cost of caring for those with Alzheimer's and other dementias is estimated to total \$290 billion in 2018. increasing to **\$1.1 trillion** (in today's dollars) by mid-century. Nearly one in every three seniors who dies each year has Alzheimer's or another dementia.

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
