What is an Alzheimer's Association support group?

A safe place to learn, offer and receive helpful tips, and meet others coping with Alzheimer's disease or another dementia. Meetings typically take place monthly, are always free, and are open to the public.

In some areas, specially designed support groups are available for people with early-stage memory loss, male caregivers, adult children caregivers, younger partners and frontotemporal degeneration. Some groups provide transportation service or care for people with dementia during the meetings.

Why do you need a support group?


Participation in a support group can be an empowering experience, helping members feel better prepared to cope with their unique situation, more able to confront their daily problems, and more hopeful about their future.
