COMMUNITY CONNECT PROGRAMS

AFTERNOON AT THE ANTON

Afternoon at the Anton is a free program done in collaboration with the Anton Art Center. During the program we will have a facilitated art discussion followed by art creation in the studio. No artistic experience is required! Pre-registration is required one week in advance.

DETROIT HISTORICAL MUSEUM

The story of the Lions catching on in Detroit doubles as the story of professional football finding its place in American popular culture. Before the Portsmouth Spartans relocated to Detroit and donned the Honolulu Blue in 1934, several pro football teams tried and failed to gain a foothold in the city. What made the Lions different? With Detroit as its case study, this presentation examines the instability of the infant NFL and how the Lions (and professional football) won the hearts of Detroiters to become the institution they are today, tracking the team from the beginning through its golden age in the 1950s, and into the present. Join us for a catered lunch and this presentation about Detroit's hometown team.

EARLY-STAGE SOCIAL CLUB

The Early-Stage Social Club is a recreational program that promotes cognitive, physical and social well-being for individuals in the early stages of Alzheimer's disease or another dementia. Meetings feature free chair yoga followed by a coffee social and participant driven activities.

MEET ME @ THE BBAC

Meet Me @ the BBAC (Birmingham Bloomfield Art Center) is an ongoing program for people living with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias and their care partners to create meaningful experiences together through art. Join us for facilitated discussion and art studio time. RSVP required by the Tuesday before the event.

MEMORY CAFÉS

Our memory cafés are a gathering of people living in all stages of dementia and their care partners. They create an opportunity to spend time together in a welcoming place sharing stories with others who are living a similar journey. Food is available for purchase at Mimi's Bistro and the Clawson Grill. Lunch and an activity are provided at the Livonia Memory Café.

MINDS IN THE WILD AT THE DETROIT ZOO

Slither, hop, fly or walk! Join us at the Detroit Zoo in Royal Oak for Minds in the Wild where we will enjoy themed visits lead by Zoo staff. We will gather to learn and share. Join us for this monthly outing where we explore different exhibits and animal groups each month!

MINDS ON ART

Minds on Art, done in collaboration with the Detroit Institute of Arts, is a free, five-week program for people living with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias and a companion. No artistic experience required.

THE HENRY FORD OUTINGS

Join us as we partner with the Henry Ford for a free series of guided tours, which will include reminiscence, group discussion and exploration! The 1850 dining experience at Eagle Tavern in Greenfield Village involved a lot of research into food, beverages and the dining habits of travelers at the time. We'll take a deep dive into how we created this program, with period food and drink sampling included!

The Community Connect program is designed to provide people living with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia and their care partners with a broad range of socialization and culturally significant events and outings. Unless otherwise noted, all of our Community Connect Programs are free.
