Cost: Tour is free. Optional lunch is at your own expense.

Description: In 1857 the St. Louis Police Department started photographing criminal suspects. These images were then displayed at the police station in what was known as a "rogues' gallery," a phenomenon that later caught on nationally. St. Louisans were encouraged to visit the police station regularly to familiarize themselves with the suspects' faces. Now these rare portraits, taken between 1857 and 1867, are on public display once again in The St. Louis Rogues' Gallery, an Atrium installation. The images and the stories behind them provide a singular glimpse of life and crime in mid-19th century St. Louis.
