Overview of Alzheimer's Association

Internship Responsibilities

Working with the Manager of Medical and Scientific Research Engagement, the intern will provide support for various programs including TrialMatch outreach and research event planning. TrialMatch is an online clinical studies matching service to connect individuals with dementia, caregivers, and healthy volunteers with local research studies in which they may be eligible to participate. Additionally, the intern will:

- Develop a strong understanding of the TrialMatch program
- Assist in research education event planning and outreach
- Input and analyze data from TrialMatch and research event surveys
- Help coordinate Facebook Live research presentations
- Other support as needed
